Moriah Centre is changing its curriculum and has decided to teach the ACE (Accelerated Christian Education) curriculum starting in 2009 school year. There is a cost involved to use their materials. Currently, the Moriah Centre is preschool through 6th Grade. The plan is to add a new grade each year, as the present kids advance, and eventually go thru to 12th grade. Almost 50% of the kids in Swaziland are not attending school. So, the Moriah Centre will become a Mission School along with 8 others in Swaziland. With the change in curriculum, there are new requests that need to be fulfilled. One, more classrooms will be necessary. Two, the cost for each child will increase and so we are making available a portfolio of each child and the cost to support one child for one year of school. More information will be forth coming in the next few weeks. Please pray for the Moriah Centre that they can increase the number of students and will be able to hire more teachers.

2009—Building Fund

2009 UPDATES

- ⇒ 14 pupils to be the first ACE class at Moriah Centre. Pre-school class will be doing a preparatory course to lead into the ACE class for next year. There are 15 pre-school students in this class. Course was developed by a lovely lady in South Africa and is being used in two schools in South Africa as well.
- ⇒ 4 new outhouses are being built at a cost of \$3,000.00. We only had one up till now. A Blessing!
